**SUBJECT:** Amendments to THE GAS INSPECTIONS REGULATIONS

Effective December 11, 2015, Cabinet approved two amendments to The Gas Inspection Regulations.

It is important that you are aware of these two amendments.

## **Maximum Penalty**

The maximum penalty that may be imposed for performing gas installation work without a permit (section 13.1) is increased from \$250 to \$2,500 for each item of work performed without a permit.

## **Standards for Installations**

The following documents are adopted (section 16(1)) as standards for the installation of equipment or apparatus under specific circumstances:

CSA-B149.1-15: Natural Gas and Propane Installation Code

CSA-B149.2-15: Propane Storage and Handling Code

CSA-149.6-15: Code for Biogas Generation and Utilization

CSA-B108-14: Compressed Natural Gas Fuelling Stations Installation Code

CSA-B149.3-15: Code for the Field Approval of Fuel-Related Components on Appliances and Equipment

CAN/BNQ/1784-000/2007: Canadian Hydrogen Installation Code

CSA-B149.5-15: Installation Code for Propane Fuel Systems and Containers on Motor Vehicles

As announced in Bulletin 01-2015, the Saskatchewan adoption of the 2015 CSA B149.1, CSA B149.2 and CSA B149.3 gas codes, will be enforced on permits dated on or after **January 1, 2016**.
